- We use eco-friendly suppliers for publication printing, conference materials...
- Our parcels are packed with Envirofill pellets - a starch made from a combination of wheat and potato. You can even place them in your compost or on your garden to biodegrade naturally.
- We use GreenFleet to calculate carbon emissions generated by delivering our products all around the world. It has been determined that with current sales volume, 118 tons of CO₂ are emitted annually. ONEgroup have therefore agreed to plant sufficient native trees to offset these carbon emissions and revisit their volume on a quarterly basis to ensure an adequate amount of trees are planted to stay carbon neutral. www.greenfleet.com.au
- Our production facility's carbon emissions have been neutralised by paying for renewable energy such as wind and solar power to be fed into the grid to replace the fossil fuel energy once used. This has been achieved through the accredited green power company Climate Friendly. www.climatefriendly.com

Animal Testing FAQ:

Q: Are you a cruelty free (to animals) company?

A: Of course! The only animals we test on are the party-animals amongst the factory and office staff! We do not test any of our products, or ingredients on animals - nor do we ask any of our suppliers to test on our behalf.

Q: Do you buy ingredients from other companies that test on animals?

A: No. Most of our suppliers are organic farmers, or intermediaries.

Q: Why do you not have the animal cruelty free logo?

A: Our ingredients are all food-based ingredients, which is why the animal testing is a moot point for us. Any ingredient used in cosmetics, by law, must be tested on animals - so the bunny logo is really misleading! It's not difficult for ANY company, even ones that use ingredients that have been tested on animals, to get the logo. As long as none of its products and none of its product ingredients have been tested on animals by it, by anyone on its behalf, by its suppliers or anyone on their behalf at any time within a period of five years immediately preceding the date of application for accreditation. But make no mistake - ALL chemicals have been tested on animals at some time in the past.
